Population Most of our patients are 65 and over, however

we do see patients ages 10-100.

Clinical Setting Main office is over 6,000sq ft. It is staffed by 2

optometrist and 1-2 specialists depending on the day. Students are assigned to a different doctor each day and that schedule rotates. Half of the time the students are required to work up patients to dilation. The other half they will perform full work ups with treatment/ management or health

assessments depending on the patient.

We have 16 fully equipped exam rooms. We also have: 2 Humphrey Visual Field machines, OCT,

Topographer, fundus camera, B-Scan, Pachymeter and autorefractor.

All patient records are kept and recorded electronically.

We also order lab tests, neuro-imaging, medications, and consult with other health and eye care providers.

Students will meet with a doctor weekly. They will present their favorite case of the week and then the doctor will lecture for 30 minutes on selected subjects.

All equipment is provided but students are encouraged to bring their own diagnostic lenses. Name tags are required.
